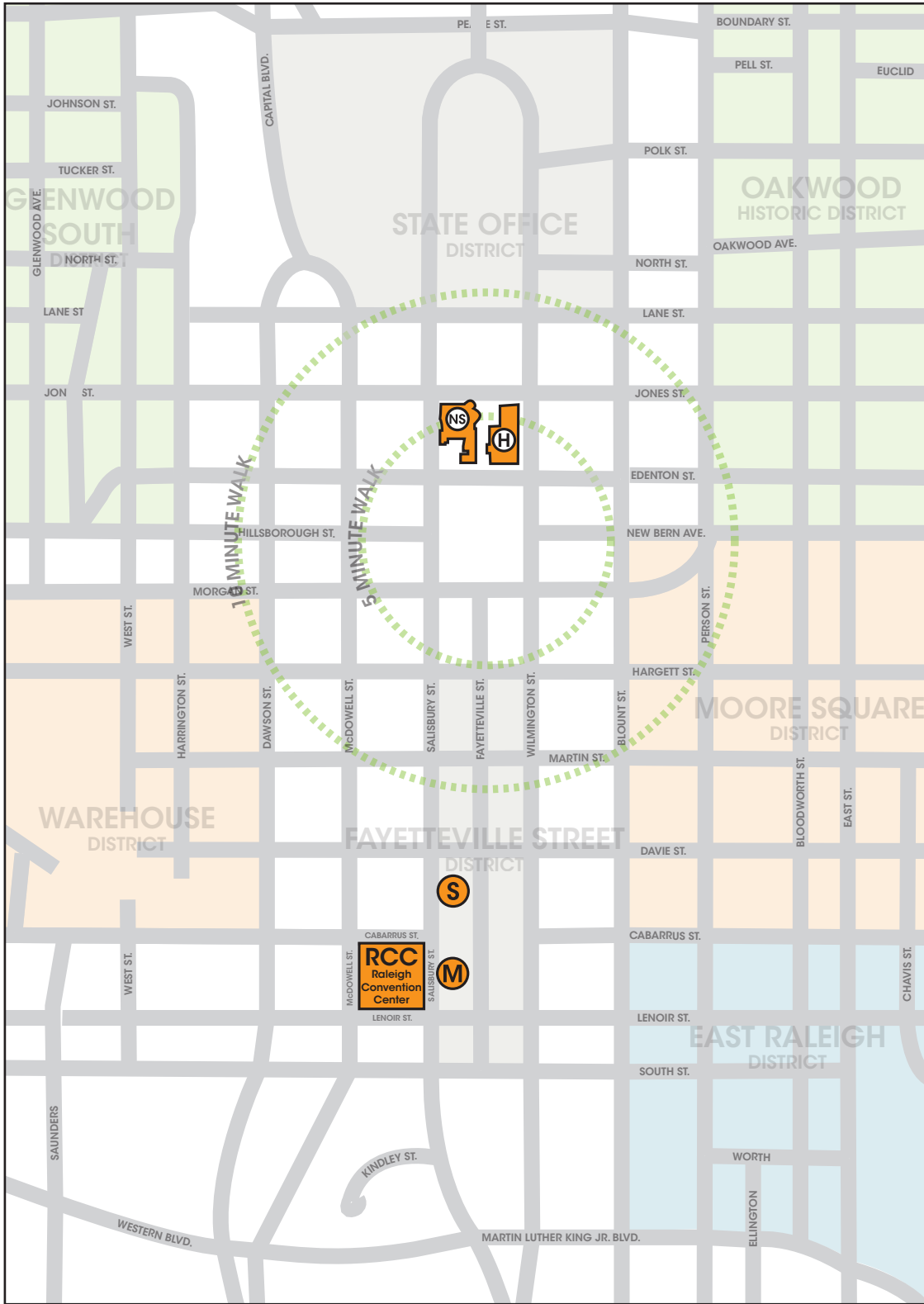


2009 IASP WORLD CONFERENCE: MAP OF DOWNTOWN RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

The Registration Desk is located in Ballroom C of the Raleigh Convention Center. Conference delegates should visit the Registration Desk to sign in, pick up conference materials, and obtain badges. Please note that admittance to all sessions and functions requires that you wear your badge. Some events are "ticketed" and will require presentation of the ticket for admittance. SESSION LOCATIONS

All of the sessions for the IASP Conference will be located in the Raleigh Convention Center.

ATTIRE

With the exception of the Gala Dinner, all social events and conference sessions are business casual. For men, slacks and a long-sleeved, collared shirt are appropriate. A jacket and necktie are not required. For women, slacks or a skirt with a blouse or sweater is appropriate. For the cooler evenings and the occasional cool day, consider bringing a lightweight jacket. Dress for the Gala Dinner is business professional. For men, a business suit or sport coat and dress slacks is appropriate. For women, a business suit (slacks, skirt or dress) or business slacks or skirt with a blouse or sweater is appropriate.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation for tours and offsite events departs in front of the Raleigh Convention Center on Salisbury Street, in front of the main entrance.

EMERGENCIES

The safety and security of delegates and staff are the first priority of the conference organizers and the Raleigh Convention Center. For fire and medical emergencies, please dial/call "911" first, then "8911" for the Convention Center Security Command Post from any house phone located throughout the facility and one in each meeting room. Delegates may also dial "8500" for Raleigh Convention Center Front Desk from any house phone for non-life threatening emergencies.

MEDICAL ACCESS
